U.S. Embassy Solicitation Amendment #19AS2021P0141-P0001

The purpose of this document is to amend section “B. SCOPE OF WORK” of Solicitation #19AS2021P0141 to include requirements clarifications in accordance with the clause 52.236-27 site visit (construction). The site visit happened on February 17, 2021.

B.2.a.1 (Amended for Clarification) The contractor shall be responsible for the professional quality, technical accuracy, and the coordination of all construction and other services furnished under this contract. The contractor shall, without additional compensation, correct or revise any errors or deficiencies in its construction and other services.

B.2.c.1 (Amended for Clarification) The new retaining walls style is to be random quarry saw cut Sydney sandstone blocks 80 mm thick minimum. The new walls to be designed with 100/150 mm reinforced concrete slab single layer F82 mesh. The walls base and section thickness, vertical joints distribution, and slopes to be engineered to accommodate the structural material properties, wall heights and the lateral loads in accordance with the Australian Standard 4678. Top of the wall and steps finish to match the walls style.

B.2.c.2 (Amended for Clarification) The new retaining walls to accommodate the safety and stability of all existing structures. The new walls must allow for 1000 mm minimum access to the house. The above ground fence to be reinstated to the exact property boundary limits.

B.2.d.1 (Amended for Clarification) The contractor shall be responsible to make good all landscape, hardscape, structures, and finishes affected by demolition and/or new work. The contractor shall be responsible to reinstate pavers and steppingstones, reinstate new wire fence and new fence poles, reinstate, and reconnect the underground utilities, reinstate and add new topsoil and sod over any exposed soil that is disturbed and/or damaged by demolition and/or new work.

B.2.e.1 (Amended for Clarification) The contractor shall be responsible for all damages to persons or property that occurs because of the contractor’s activities. The contractor shall supply all materials and labor necessary to provide protection to traffic areas (either vehicular or personnel), lawn, floors, stairs and walls from dirt, dust, damage, and wall scrapes and provide suitable dust control. The contractor shall supply temporary fencing boundary walls as necessary to maintain the privacy of the construction crew, the property residents, and the neighbors.
