STATEMENT OF WORK CARGO TRUCK

1.0 Overview

The United States Government (USG) has a requirement to purchase one Cargo Truck.

2.0 Scope Description

The contractor to supply one Cargo Truck that includes all the following specifications.

2.1 Truck specifications,

1. Right Hand drive Australian compliance vehicle
2. Color: White
3. Seats: Three
4. GVM: 4500kg
5. Engine: Diesel Minimum 110kW ADR 80/03 compliant
6. Transmission: Automatic Transmission
7. Front & Rear Disc Brakes
8. Fuel Tank: Minimum 100 Litre with lockable fuel cap
9. Anti-lock braking system (ABS)
10. Central locking, remote keyless entry, and immobilizer
11. Electric windows
12. Integrated climate control air conditioning
13. Adjustable steering column
14. Overhead storage console
15. AM/FM Radio with Satellite Navigation
16. Driver & passenger airbags

2.2 Pantech Body Specifications,

1. 4.3m long x 2.185m wide x 2.085m High, Solid Fiberglass Panel sides finished in white to match cabin.
2. Rear "Barn doors" each with 3 hinges, cam locks, and door retainers, opening size of 1965mm high x 2085mm wide. Must be able to be opened with tailgate loader in stored position.
3. Internal tie rails on each side.
4. Flat Plate Metal floor
5. Nonslip step on each side at rear.
6. Interior light and switch wired through park lights.
7. Clearance lights on top front and rear of Pantech.
8. Fold under tailgate loader minimum width 1600mm x depth 1200mm (opened) minimum capacity 500Kg. With 1 remote controller and 1 fixed controller.

Offering must be a make and model that is common in Australia so that the vehicle blends into the local environment.

5.2 All items must be delivered to by June 10th, 2021.

6.0 Vehicle Registration Process with U.S. Embassy, GSO, Canberra, Australia:

The contractor is responsible for coordinating all the on-road cost, which includes Australian Capital Territory vehicle registration. Prior to the contractor registering the vehicle, the contractor is required to contact with the Embassy (GSO) to get the diplomatic exemptions.

7.0 Australian Safety Standards and Vehicle Compliance:

The vehicle must meet Australian Safety Standards as per **Motor Vehicle Regulations 1989**
